	He	is	not	a nurse.	He's not a nurse. He isn't a nurse.
	She	is	not	a student.	She's not a student. She isn't a student.
	It	is	not	a cat.	It's not a cat. It isn't a cat.
	We	are	not	enemies.	We're not enemies. We aren't enemies.
	They	are	not	American.	They're not American. They aren't American.
