Would like (modal auxiliary)

We use **would like** to say politely what we want, to make invitations and offers, and to ask about preferences in general.

Check the following charts, notice the difference between using the auxiliary followed by a noun and followed by a verb.

	Subject	Auxiliary verb	Main verb	Noun
+	She	would	like	coffee.
-	He	would not wouldn't	like	whisky.
?	Would	you	like	some sugar?

When we want to invite someone to do something we add TO + VERB

	Subject	Auxiliary verb	Main verb	ТО	Verb
+	She	would	like	to	go.
-	He	would not wouldn't	like	to	stay home.
?	Would	you	like	to	dance?
