VERB TO BE	SUBJECT	VERB GERUND (ing)	COMPLEMENT	ANSWERS
Am	I	singing	in the shower?	Yes, you are. No, you're not.
Are	you	playing	soccer?	Yes, I am. No, I'm not.
Is	he	studying	Administration?	Yes, he is. No, he isn't.
Is	she	working	at a bank?	Yes, she is. No, she isn't.
Is	it	sleeping	in the yard?	Yes, it is. No, it isn't.
Are	we	dancing	salsa?	Yes, we are. No, we're not.
Are	they	drinking	soda?	Yes, they are. No, they aren't.



WH QUESTIONS

When we want to know more information, we add a WH QUESTION WORD at the beginning of a yes/no question.

WH QUESTION WORDS	USED TO TALK ABOUT	Example
How	manners	How are you feeling right now?
Why	reasons	Why is she crying at the moment?
Which	to choose an option	Which boy is dancing better?
What	things	What are you doing now?
Where	places	Where are they staying tonight?
Who	people	Who is swimming now?
