	It	is	sleeping	in the yard.
	We	are	dancing	salsa.
	They	are	drinking	soda.

<b>Negative Sentences (-)</b>	SUBJECT	VERB TO BE	NOT	VERB (ing) GERUND	COMPLEMENT
	I	am	not	singing	in the shower.
	You	are	not	playing	soccer.
	He	is	not	studying	Administration.
	She	is	not	working	at a bank.
	It	is	not	sleeping	in the yard.
	We	are	not	dancing	salsa.
	They	are	not	drinking	soda.
