



Quantifiers

Quantifiers are used to express quantities about people without saying a specific number, or to replace a percentage.



All
Nearly all
Most
Many
A lot of
Some
Not many
Few
No one

Examples:

100% CUCEA students are cool = **All** CUCEA students are cool.

90% Mexicans drink tequila = **Nearly all** Mexicans drink tequila.

85% men love soccer = **Most** men love soccer.

25% children like vegetables = **Not many** children like vegetables.

0% people in Latin America wear fur coats = **No one** in Latin America wears fur coats.
