To talk about something that you regularly did in the past but you don't do anymore or no longer happens.

- Notice that the structure is the same for all the subject pronouns.

Affirmative

It	used to	be	bigger.

Negative

Subject	Auxiliary "didn't use to"	Verb base form	Complement
I	didn't use to	drive	a motorcycle.
You	didn't use to	like	vegetables.
He	didn't use to	have	a girlfriend.
She	didn't use to	wear	dresses.
It	didn't use to	bark	at nights.
We	didn't use to	dance	salsa.
They	didn't use to	climb	trees.
