INDIRECT QUESTIONS

We use them to ask questions in a more polite way.

They always start with introductory phrases such as: Could you tell me, I wonder, Do you know, I'd like to know, Can you remember, I don't know, etc.

Indirect questions follow the word order of a regular sentence.

• If the introductory phrase is a question, you need to add a question mark (?) at the end.

Introductory Phrases	Simple questions	Indirect questions
Could you tell me	Where is the restaurant?	Could you tell me where the restaurant is?
I wonder	Who is that?	I wonder who that is.
I don't know	Where is the ATM?	I don't know where the ATM is.
Do you know	What time does the museum open?	Do you know what time the museum opens?
I'd like to know	Where can I buy good food?	I'd like to know where I can buy good food.
Can you remember	What did we eat for lunch?	Can you remember what we ate for lunch?
