



## INDIRECT QUESTIONS

**We use them to ask questions in a more polite way.**

**They always start with introductory phrases such as:  
Could you tell me, I wonder, Do you know, I'd like to know,  
Can you remember, I don't know, etc.**

**Indirect questions follow the word order of a regular sentence.**

- If the introductory phrase is a question, you need to add a question mark (?) at the end.***

Introductory Phrases	Simple questions	Indirect questions
Could you tell me	Where <b>is</b> the restaurant?	Could you tell me where the restaurant <b>is</b> ?
I wonder	Who is that?	I wonder who that <b>is</b> .
I don't know.....	Where is the ATM?	I don't know where the ATM <b>is</b> .
Do you know....	What time <b>does</b> the museum open?	Do you know what time the museum <b>opens</b> ?
I'd like to know...	Where <b>can</b> I buy good food?	I'd like to know where <b>I can</b> buy good food.
Can you remember	What <b>did</b> we eat for lunch?	Can you remember what we <b>ate</b> for lunch?
