Subject	Verb in Simple Past	Complement	Subject	auxiliary	Verb in base form	Complement
I You We They	ate	a sandwich in the morning.	I You We They	didn't	go	to school today.

### Remember:

In **present perfect** the important part is the **experience**.  
In **simple past** the important part is the **time of the action**.
