



Future with BE GOING TO (To talk about planned activities, or when you are sure they are going to happen)				
SUBJECT	BE	Aux GOING TO	VERB BASE FORM	Complement / Time expression.
I	am	going to	play	basketball next week.
You	are	going to	fly	to Dubai next Friday.
He	is	going to	buy	a bike tomorrow.
She	is	going to	drive	to CUCEA next year.
It	is	going to	run	fast next month.
We	are	going to	have	fun next weekend.
They	are	going to	make	cards next Christmas.

Future with WILL (To talk about uncertain activities, or when you are not sure they will happen; predictions, last minute decisions, the weather)			
SUBJECT	Aux WILL	VERB BASE FORM	Complement / Time expression.
I	will	go	to NY next year.
You	will	win	next summer.
He	will	call	you next Friday.
She	will	run	faster next time.
It	will	have	puppies next month.
We	will	see	it next semester.
They	will	travel	to Canada next year.



To make negative statements with Future BE GOING TO you simply add NOT after verb BE.

I am **not going to play basketball next week.**
Contraction: I'm not going to play basketball next week.

He is **not going to buy a bike tomorrow.**
Contraction: He isn't going to buy a bike tomorrow.

They are **not going to make cards next Christmas.**
Contraction: They're not going to make cards next Christmas.

To make negative statements with Future WILL you simply add NOT after the auxiliary.

I will **not go to NY next year.**
Contraction: I won't go to NY next year.

He will **not call you next Friday.**
Contraction: He won't call you next Friday.

They will **not travel to Canada next year.**
Contraction: They won't travel to Canada next year.
