CONCEPT	DEFINITION
<b>achievement</b>	An accomplishment
<b>assassination</b>	The murder of someone. This is usually for political reasons.
<b>discovery</b>	To find something that was unknown.
<b>election</b>	The election of someone by voting.
<b>epidemic</b>	A temporary disease that spreads rapidly.
<b>natural disaster</b>	An event or force of nature such as a flood, earthquake, hurricane, etc.
<b>revolution</b>	Change in power often accompany by violence.
<b>terrorist act</b>	Use of violence to achieve goals that are political, religious or ideological in nature. This is the act of causing terror.
