#### **ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

Present perfect or Simple past

# What have you achieved so far in your life?

Present perfect
I have managed to get good grades.
I have been able to buy a new car.
I have managed to get a good job.
Simple past
I managed to get good grades.
I was able to buy a new car.
I managed to get a good job.

### GOALS

Future perfect or Would like to have + verb in past participle

what will you have achieved by the year 2000?
Future perfect
I hope I will have traveled to Europe and Asia.
I will have bought a beach house by the time I am 50 years old.
I will have had grandchildren in 2050.
Would like to have + verb in past participle
I would like to have traveled to Europe and Asia.
I would like to have bought a beach house by the time I am 50 years old.
I would like to have had grandchildren in 2050.
