Types of family:

A nuclear family is made up of parents and one or more children living together.

A **single-parent family** is when only one parent supports and raises the children. In other words, either the mom doesn't have a husband or the dad doesn't have a wife.

An **extended family** is made up of parents, children and one or more relatives (a grandma, an uncle, a cousin, etc...) living under the same roof.
