



## Family vocabulary

Here you will learn some compound nouns to talk about family.

<b>When you are related to your grandma's or grandpa's brother or sister:</b>  Great-aunt,  Great-nephew,  Great-niece,  Great-uncle	<b>When you are related to your mother's or father's mom or dad:</b>  Grandfather,  Grandmother,  Granddaughter,  Grandson,
<b>When you are related to your grandma's or grandpa's mom or dad:</b>  Great-granddaughter,  Great-grandfather,  Great-grandmother,  Great-grandson	<b>When you are related to your spouse's family:</b>  mother-in-law,  father-in-law  brother-in-law,  sister-in-law  daughter-in-law,  in-laws
<b>Types of family:</b>  A <b>nuclear family</b> is made up of parents and one or more children living together.  A <b>single-parent family</b> is when only one parent supports and raises the children. In other words, either the mom doesn't have a husband or the dad doesn't have a wife.  An <b>extended family</b> is made up of parents, children and one or more relatives (a grandma, an uncle, a cousin, etc...) living under the same roof.
